Recyclable:

- Lobster trap tags
- Bottle caps/ Small type 2 or 5 plastic bottles
- Shotgun shells
- Clean rope
- Metals
- Lobster traps

New this year for recycling:

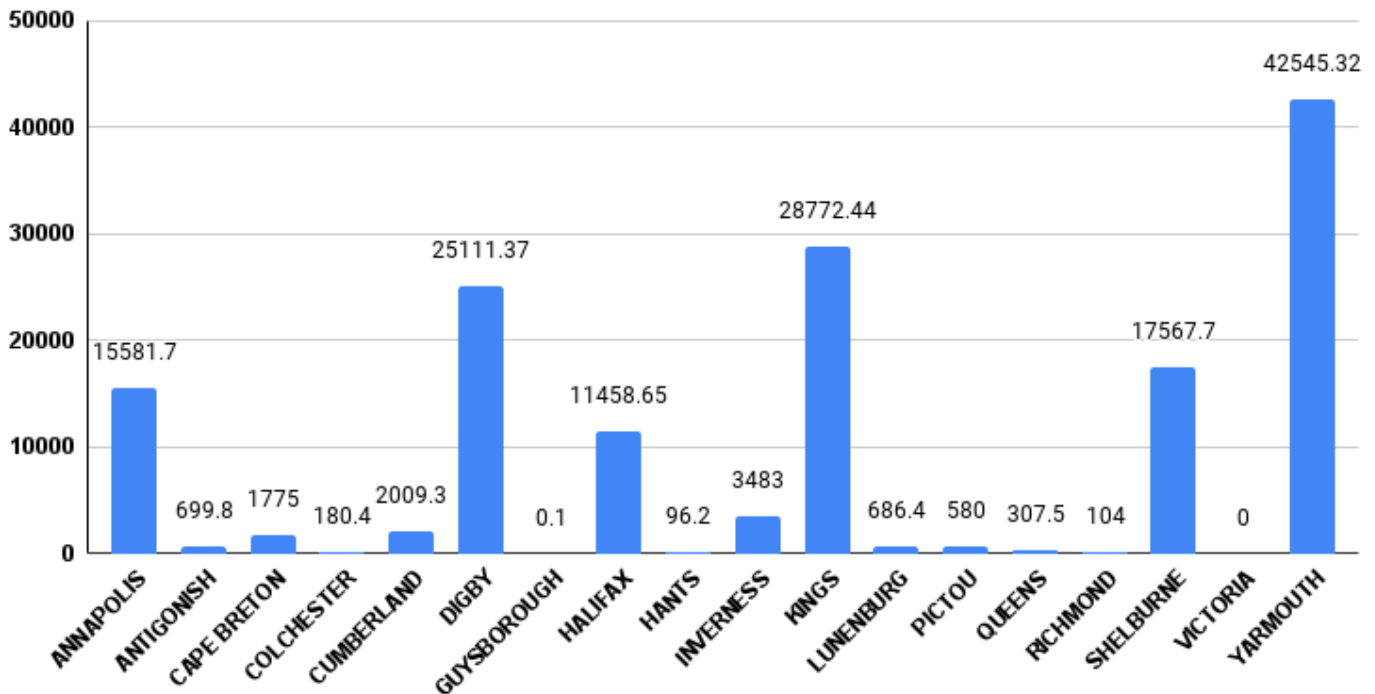
- All rigid marine plastics
- Bait box strapping
- Polypropylene nets/Bait bags
- Escape hatches

Reusable:

- Intact buoys
- Fishing gear such as trap hooks, bait spikes, composite, dog bones, swivels are often returned to fishers
- Rope in good condition (Often in rope crafts!)
