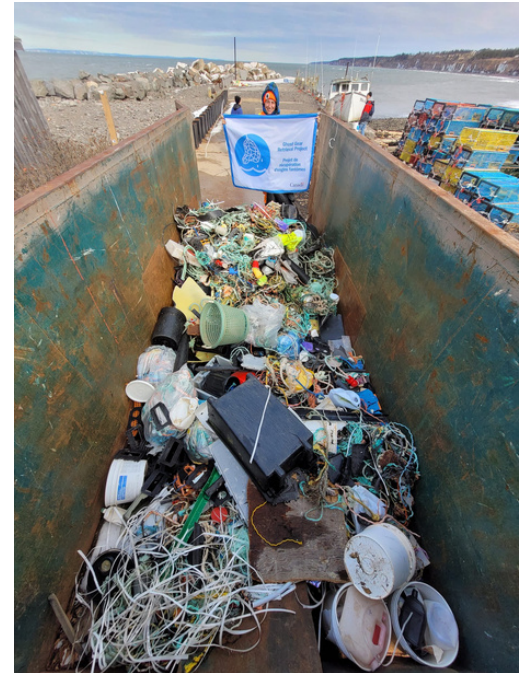

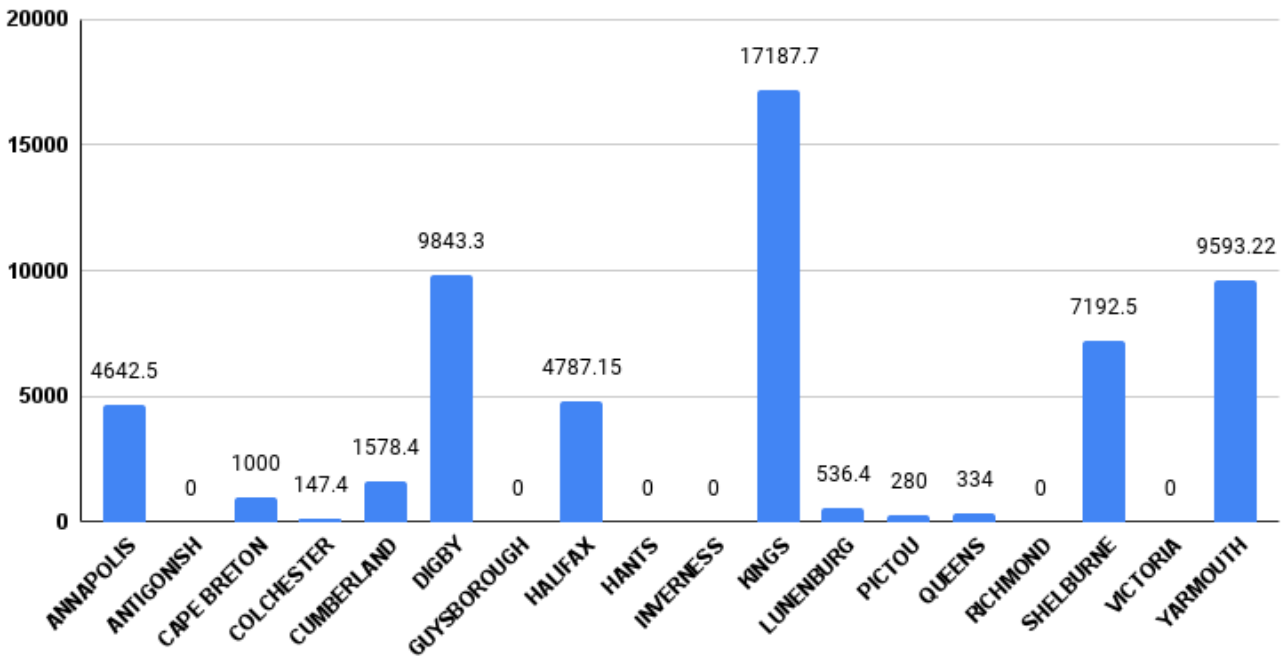


## Shoutout to our solo-cleaning superstars
